DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a total depth of 68 feet with rotary tools. While making connection, boulders fell on bit. Bit and subs twisted off while attempting to free bit, leaving a fish consisting of one 12 1/2" bit and 6 feet of subs in hole. Unable to recover fish due to boulders. 12 1/2" hole was plugged with 60 sacks of cement filling hole to ground level with solid concrete. Finished at 5:15 P.M., December 31, 1953. Ground was restored to original contour and rig skidded 9 feet south and new hole drilled.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
