The No. 1 Israel was shut down in September 1951 after being carried to a dept of 1820 feet. It is now the Company's intention to plug back to a depth of 1560 feet to set plugs and gun perforate with 64 holes between the depths of 1480 to 1520 feet in what is known as the Fruitland Sand, and then run rods and tubing and place well on pump to clean out and test formation that was perforated.
