Pull 2-3/8" tubing, squeeze off open hole and perforations
Junk in hole at 4900', set whipstock approximately 4300', cut
window in 5 1/2" casing
Drill through Point Lookout formation with gas
Run 3 1/2" liner
Perforate Point Lookout
Sand-water frac
Run 1 1/2" tubing
Put back on production
