

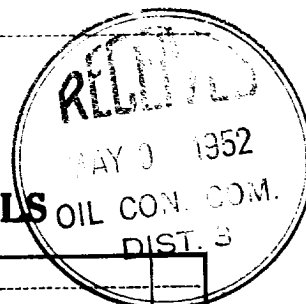

DETAILS OF WORK

Total Depth 7093' Lins. On 5-3-52 took DST #8 from 7061' to 7093'. Tool open 2 hrs. 25 min. Gas to surface in 50 minutes. Maximum measured volume of gas 100 MCF declined to 39 MCF. Recovered 900' of fluid; first 270' Gas cut drilling mud, next 630' oil and gas cut salt water. Estimated 17% oil and 83% salt water. Flowing pressure 640 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1170 $\frac{1}{2}$. 15 minute shut in 3.H.F.-3545 $\frac{1}{2}$. Hydrostatic pressure 3965 $\frac{1}{2}$.
