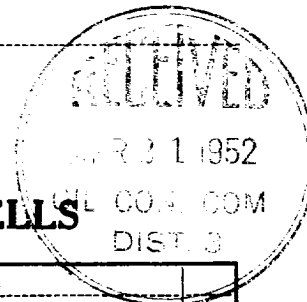

DETAILS OF WORK

Total Depth 6836' Lame. On 4-17-52 took test log from 6779' to 6836'. Test tool open 1 1/2 hrs. Gas to surface in 10 minutes. Gas gauged 3,850 cu. ft. per day. Drill pipe unloaded an estimated 180' of gas cut mud after pulling 4400' out of hole. In addition recovered 900' of fluid, first 450' slightly oil cut water, next 180' water heavily cut with light green oil, and 270' salt water. Flowing pressure 280 to 270 ps. 30 minute shut in 34F-2580 ps. Hydrostatic pressure 3420 ps.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
