As a result of the above well ceasing to produce oil in commercial quantities, we plugged and abandoned it January 30, 1965 as follows:

1. Pumped 50 sacks cement plug down 5-1/2" casing. Leaving plug from 2600 (top perforation 2644) to 2880 (PBD).
2. Attempted to pump cement down 9-5/8" - 5-1/2" casing annulus with 1000 psi, no success. Cement from second stage on 5-1/2 casing apparently filled to base of 9-5/8" casing at 210'.
3. Removed well head and surface equipment. Mixed 5 sacks cement and placed between 5-1/2" and 9-5/8" casing strings.
4. Filled casing between plugs with fluid.
5. Spotted 5 sacks cement plug 0-40' and welded top of 5-1/2" and 9-5/8" casing strings together.
6. Erected abandonment marker and cleaned up location.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
