Dear Mr. Porter:

We requested by letter, dated April 25, 1974, administrative approval for an unorthodox well to be located 2180' from the South Line and 890' from the West Line of Section 13, T-30N, R-8W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico and received approval by administrative order NSL-662 dated, May 20, 1974.

However, this location was rejected by the United States Bureau of Land Management as being too near New Mexico State Highway No. 511.

We request that administrative order NSL-662 be set aside and approval for a different location, to be known as Northeast Blanco Unit No. 63, located 350' from the South Line, 1890' from the West Line, Section 13, T-30N, R-8W, San Juan County, New Mexico, be granted.

The offset acreage will not be affected by this location.
