There was not a release of produced water from the fiberglass tank as the fire burnt down to the water level within the effected tank. The damaged tank and any effected equipment have been removed and will be replaced. This battery is also lined and bermed. **Depth to Ground Water: 50-99' (approximately 50', per ChevronTexaco Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 10. Based on no produced water was released from the fire, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests closure.**
