I would like to know (exactly) when; how (seeding method); labeled before and after photos etc. NMSLO will only close remediation permits when revegetation is achieved, not attempted.

From the attached photos I cannot tell the current conditions, but since this release is more than 2 years old I'm assuming that it has washed off the vegetation.
