Chevron USA respectfully requests the following sales line expansion.

The sales gas pipeline at Salado Draw CTB 19 in Section 19, T26S-R33E of South Lea County is currently a 4" carbon steel pipeline. At this pipeline size, at approximately 8 MMSCFD of gas throughput, the pipeline would be at the erosional velocity, i.e. the velocity at which the gas begins to erode the pipeline wall, presenting a significant safety risk.

The forecasted production for CTB 19 includes gas production peaks of 28-31 MMSCFD in June 2019 & 49-56 MMSCFD in July 2020. At these forecasted rates, assuming the Compressor Station is loaded by production from Salado Draw CTB 29, a 10" sales gas pipeline would be sized to ensure Salado Draw CTB 19 is operating safely within its design limits. The sales gas pipeline is contained on the Salado Draw CTB 19 Pad as well as the Salado Draw Pad 3. No new surface disturbance is in scope for


