FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Drilled 8 3/4" hole to total depth of 11880 ft. in Devonian topped at 11747* ft. Ran 11756 ft. or 359* fts. of 5 1/2" OD 17 & 20# N-80 casing set at 11775 ft. and cemented first stage with 200 sax by HOWCO. Ran temperature survey and found top of cement at 10970 ft. Perforated 4 - 1/2" holes at 10970 ft. HOWCO set DM squeeze packer at 10940 ft. and cemented 2nd stage with 1400 sax 6% Jel cement; final pressure 2500 psi with 1100 to 1800 psi on annulus. HOWCO ran temperature survey and found top of cement at 4150 ft., 9 5/8" shoe was at 4221 ft. Plan to test casing shut-off at 5:00 PM tomorrow, Sept. 28, 1950.
