Set 5 1/2" casing at 13,540', using 100 centralizers, 452 scratchers and 1,518 sacks cement. Plug down at 9:55 P.M., September 22, 1953. Temperature survey showed top of cement outside 5 1/2" casing at 5,600'.

On September 24, 1953, tested casing with 1,000# pressure for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug. No pressure drop.
