DETAILS OF WORK

On Sept. 24, 1950, 72' of 10-3/4" OD 40.5# casing was cemented at 77' with 40 sacks of cement. Cement did not circulate, so on Sept. 25, 1950, 30 additional sacks were placed from the surface, making a total of 70 sacks. Drilling will not be resumed before 24 hours. No water was encountered.
