This is to advise of the drilling and completion of an additional oil well on our Phillips "E" State Lease in the Maljamar-Grayburg/San Andres Field, Lea County, New Mexico. Our Well No. 10 on this lease was potentialed on March 3, 1969. Completion report forms on this well are being submitted this date.

The Phillips "E" State Lease is operated as the Northeast Maljamar Waterflood Unit which was approved by Order No. R3154. The well and/or proration unit count used in calculating maximum project allowable should now be increased from 9 to 10 with the top project allowable scheduled at 10 times the top unit allowable, effective with the completion of Well No. 10.
