On November 1, 1943 we shot the above well with 500 quarts of Nitro-Glycerin, the top being 4200 feet and bottom 4500 feet, using 3 quarts to the foot. After the well was cleaned out to the bottom same was put on a ten hour test, which the well produced 23 barrels per hour on this ten hour test.
