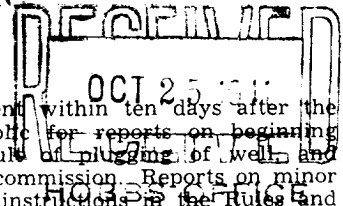

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4561 Line. Reamed hole to bottom. Placed 14' gravel anchor from 4561 to 4547. Dumped calseal 4547 to 4541. Ran 410 Qts E.L. 357 Glycerine from 4541 to 4340. Placed 12' gravel from 4340 to 4328. Dumped calseal from 4328 to 4225. Set time bomb to detonate 2 PM, September 9, 1941. Beckman cleaned out after shot with reverse circulation. Ran 2" tubing to 4529 with American Flow packer at 4053. Swabbed circulating oil out and well failed to flow. Installed Kobe pump on well, pumped 29 bbls oil, no water, 6 hours.
