DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Halliburton dumped 72 gallons of Cal-Seal in three stages and filled up the hole from 4135' to 4090', each time testing for fill up; 100% fill up was observed on each dump. 18 gallons of Hydromite was dumped after which 700 lbs. of squeeze pressure was put on the Hydromite. After 2 hours, 100% fill up was observed with the present plug back depth being 4079'. Operator ran tubing and commenced swabbing well 24 hours from the time that the Hydromite was dumped. In this test for water shut off, the following results were obtained:

Well was swabbed dry with slight blow of gas. Shut down 1 hour and ran swab, recovering no fluid. Shut down an additional hour with the same results. Water Shut Off, O. K.
