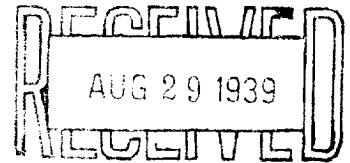
Following is a notice of intention to do certain work as described below at the Amerada Petroleum Corporation Boon Hardin Well No. 1 in SW SW 1/4 of Sec. 18, T. 18s, R. 38e, N. M. P. M., Hobbs Field, Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has declined to a point where it becomes necessary to have more gas to produce the well allowable. To accomplish this, we propose to perforate the casing from 3630' to 3670', and to set a casing packer below the perforations at approximately 3700'. The gas thus obtained will be used thru flow valves.

We request your authorization to make these repairs.

The oil string on this well is 8 5/8" 32# Seamless casing set @ 3923' and cemented with 275 sacks.
