DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Shut well in for 46 hours and 45 minutes and then shut. Well had been shut in 48 hours for static temperature survey of 25' in from the top. (2 copies of temperature survey attached)

Tested surface connections for casing leaks: 72 hr. shut in pressure - 8 5/8" - 5 1/2" was OK, 5 1/2" - 2" was OK (packer), 2" to the top was 390'. Closed Bradford between 8 5/8" - 5 1/2" and got no flow. No indication of casing leaks.

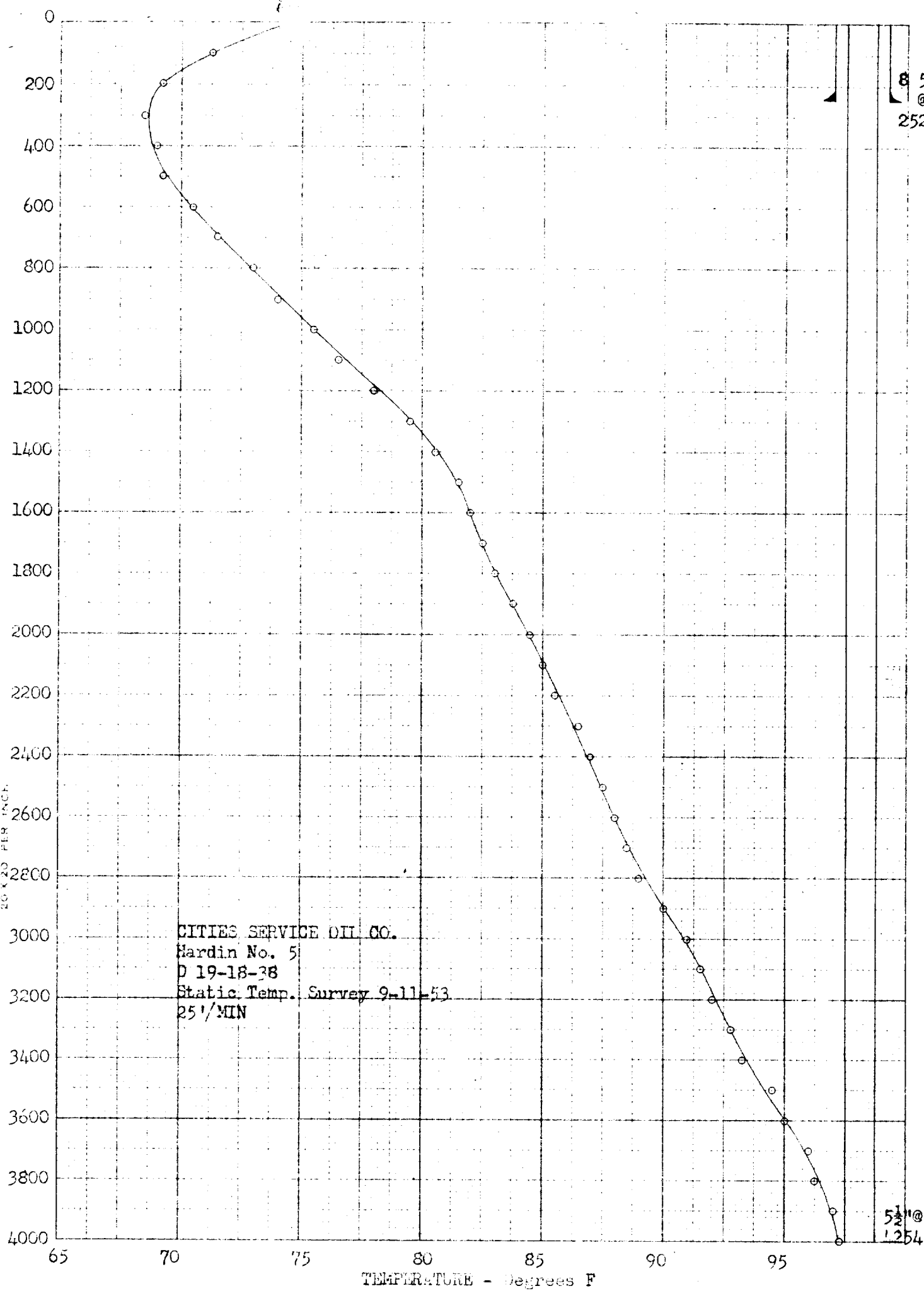
