Attached is Tidewater's Application for Dual Completion of its State "AN" Well No. 8. This well is to be a combination tubingless and conventional dual completion. The Vacuum Devonian zone will be produced through 2-3/8" tubing inside of 4-1/2" casing to be set at approximately 11,900 feet. The Vacuum Bone Springs zone will be produced through 2-7/8" casing to be at approximately 9000 feet. It is expected that both zones will flow initially.

In accordance with the Commission's Rule 112-A, it is respectfully requested that Tidewater Oil Company be granted administrative approval for this application.
