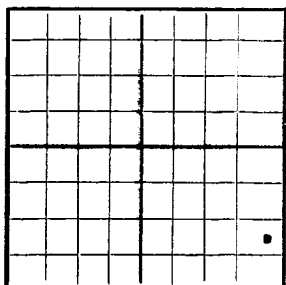

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 101 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: \$10,000 blanket surety bond of Maryland Casualty Company has been filed with State Geologist. We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:
