DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above well was treated April 3rd, 1948, by The Western Company, with 2000 gals. 20% acid, and 4000 gals. 15% acid. Following treatment well was swabbed to kick off and intermittently swabbed and flowed to clean. When clean, well flowed steadily. Was shut in to complete connections. Then flowed for three hours during which time it produced 101 barrels oil, no water, casing pressure 900-750, tubing pressure 200-70, $\frac{1}{2}$ inch choke. After three hour flow test, well was shut in
