FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We request permission to use a central tank battery to receive the production from the following wells: State of N. M. "T" (Lease No. 54527) Well No. 2 and State of N. M. "V" (Lease No. 54143) Wells Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, and two additional wells on this lease which we anticipate drilling and completing at a later date. All of these wells are located on Military Institute Land.

The central tank battery would, therefore, eventually be used to receive the production from seven wells located in the W₂ and SW₄ of SE₄ of Section 34, T-17-S, R-34-E.

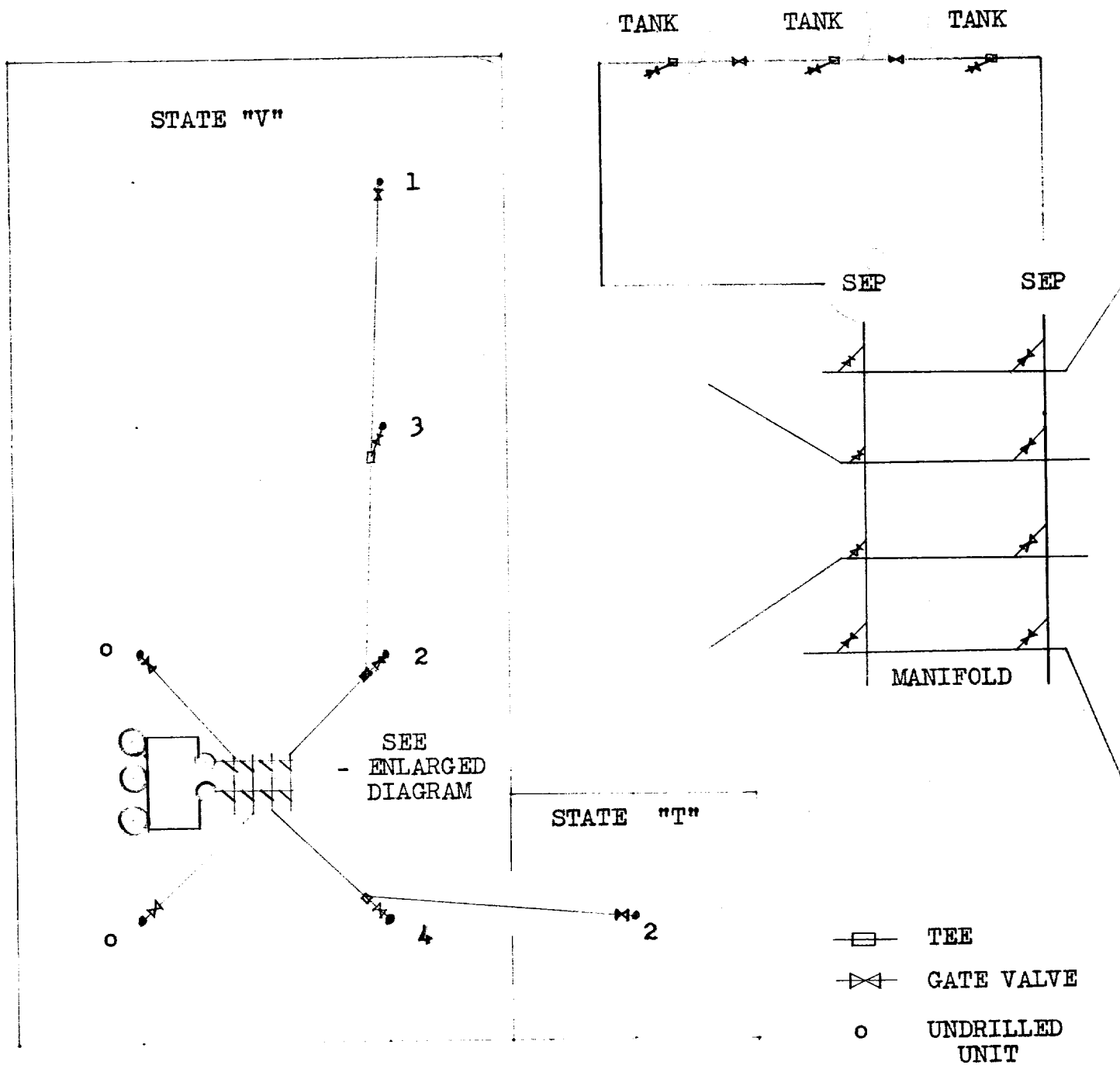
