DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented 1588' of 9-5/8", 36# New Casing at 1577' with 615 sacks of Hi Tere Oil Well cement, Halliburton process, Feb. 9, 1940. Let stand 48 hours. Tested 9-5/8" casing with 1000# hydraulic pressure, held pressure 30 minutes, pressure decreased to 960# Test O.K. Drilled plug at 1550' drilled cement out of casing and cleaned out to bottom, 1584'. Tested casing and formation with 1000# hydraulic pressure, held pressure 30 minutes, pressure decreased to 970#. Test O.K.
