Gentlemen:

By this letter of application The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

(a) That under Rule 112-A (c) The Texas Company desires to dually complete its Ma. Weir Well No. 1, Monument Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(b) That the subject well is located in the center of the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 25, T-19S, R-36E, and was originally completed August 29, 1936, at a total depth of 3990 feet. The attached gas well plat, Exhibit "A", shows the location of this well on The Texas Company's Ma. Weir Lease together with location of all offset wells.

(c) That subject well has 7" casing set at 3700 feet and cemented with 400 sacks of cement. That this well is an oil well producing from the open hole interval from 3700 to 3990 feet in the Monument Pool.

(d) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the well in the following manner:

- (1) Run 4-1/2 inch casing to a proposed depth of 3750 feet in the top of the Grayburg and cement to surface.
- (2) Perforate the 4-1/2 inch casing within the approximate interval of 3550 to 3630 feet in the Queen pay of the Monument Gas Pool.
- (3) Set a production type packer below these perforations at approximately 3700 feet to separate the two pay zones.
- (4) Produce the Grayburg-San Andres pay from the Monument Oil Pool through the tubing and the Queen pay from Monument Gas Pool through the tubing-casing annulus.
