FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

3892' TD - We plan to rig up, pull 1" tubing, flow valves, 2-7/8" OD Tubing and packer.

Run caliper survey of open hole section 3023' to 3878'. Set open hole cast iron retainer at approximately 3300'. Cement open hole below retainer with 125 sacks and leave cement on top to 3280'. Re-complete as a gas well in Blument Field from open hole 3023' to 3280'.

Note: Well is presently completed as an oil well in Monument Field, but was closed in on April 7, 1957. After recompletion, this well will serve a gas unit already in existence, namely the J. R. Phillips Gas Unit.
