Gulf Oil Corporation is the Operator of a non-standard gas pro-  
 ration unit consisting of the SW/4 of Section 8, Township 19 South, Range  
 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool. The unit well is  
 Gulf Oil Corporation's E. Shipp "B" Well No. 1 located in the NW/4 SW/4 of  
 Section 8. An application for the approval of this non-standard gas pro-  
 ration unit was filed and by your Administrative Order NSP-181 you approved  
 the formation of the unit and provided for an allowable in accordance with  
 pool rules based upon a unit of 160 acres.

Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner of leasehold interests cover-  
 ing the entire SW/4 of Section 8 and is pooling all of its interest for  
 the production of gas from this unit within the limits of the Eumont Gas  
 Pool and the Pooling Agreement is in the process of preparation for  
 execution.

Pursuant to the practice heretofore followed by the Commission,  
 you are requested to place the unit well upon the gas proration schedule,  
 effective immediately, allocating to it an allowable based upon the 160  
 acre unit in the Eumont Gas Pool.
