NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that we intend to test the shut-off of water in Capps

Well No. 31 in SW 1/4 of Sec. 3, T. 19S, R. 38E

N. M. P. M., Hobbs High Oil Field, Lea County,

on May 18, 1929 50 lb. casing was landed cemented in Line

formation at a depth of 1549 feet on May 18, 1929

50 sacks of El Toro cement were used.

The method used in placing the cement was as follows: The cement was dumped in the bottom of the hole with a cement bailer and was forced behind the casing with water pressure.

Fluid level will be bailed to a depth of DRY feet and left undisturbed for at least 12 hours before your inspection.

The cement will be allowed to set until the fifteenth, and then the cement left in the hole will be drilled out and a water shut-off test will be made.
