Dear Sir:

Under the provisions of Commission Order No. R-520, Rules 3 and 5(b), delegating the Secretary of the Commission authority to grant exceptions to the requirements of Rule No. 2 and No. 5(a) without notice and hearing for an unorthodox location and non-standard gas proration unit, respectively, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company hereby applies for an exception to the aforementioned two rules for O. J. Gillully "B" No. 6-X, Eumont Field.

In support of the above application the following data are furnished:

O. J. Gillully "B" No. 6-X is located 390' from the North line and 660' from the East line of Section 21, T-20-S, R-37-E. It was originally completed December 31, 1939, as a Monument Field oil well with an initial potential of 43 BOPD from interval 3794-3855'. Application to dually complete the well for gas in the Eumont Field was made on March 2, 1954, and was approved by Order No. DC-85, dated March 16, 1954. Application to effect the dual completion and repair the oil zone was made by USGS Form 9-331a, dated April 1, 1954, and approved on April 7, 1954. Subsequently, the oil zone was successively plugged back and tested until commercial production was obtained from perforations 3730-3756 opposite the Grayburg formation. Various intervals were then perforated from 2678 to 3495 opposite the Yates-Seven
