DETAILS OF WORK

The subject well was shut in on March, 1962.

We propose to convert SEMU Drinkard No. 9 to a Salt Water Disposal Well in the following manner: Set a CIBP at 5800 W/2 sacks cement; perforate San Andres in 2 holes per foot from 4745-55', 4559-68, 4615-22, 4627-32, 4656-68, 4671-76 & 4688-4700'; run tension packer on tubing and treat W/4000 gals 15% acid; swab test for productivity and water sample. Begin water disposal.

We propose to do this work by authority of NMOCC Administrative Order No. SWD-37.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of this work.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
