## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Dumped 200 gals Dowell XX acid on bottom with bailer, with 2 barrels of oil. Load set  $1\frac{1}{2}$  hours. Hole was bailed dry. Last two bailers 50% oil and 50% sludge. Drilled cement 3780 to 3801. No shows, hole dry. Ran bailer two trips, recovered full bailer half oil, half water. Water exhausted at 3802. Deepened to 3807. 500' oil in hole, trace water. Ran tubing and rods. In 12 hours filled tubing with 16 barrels, and pumped  $2\frac{1}{2}$  Barrels of oil and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  barrels of water in tanks.
