DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 31, 1950 at 10:00 P. M., 40 hours had elapsed since running 305' of 13-3/8" casing set at 318' and cemented with 400 sacks to be used as surface casing. Cement was circulated to surface. Pipe and water shut-off was tested by applying 2,000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before and after drilling the cement plug.

No pressure drop occurred on either test during the test period.
