DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The above well was plugged and abandoned on February 22, 1954, as set out in Form C-102 Notice of Intention to Plug Well. A 25 sack cement plug was run to total depth in the hole was loaded with mud. A total of 9000 of 5-1/2" casing was recovered from the hole & a 25 sack plug laid in the top of the 5-1/2" casing stub. A 10 sack cement plug was laid in the bottom of the surface casing and a 10 sack plug laid in the top of the surface pipe with a 1/2" steel washer extending 6" above the main ground level.
