Dear Sir:

By this letter of application Amerada Petroleum Corporation
desires to state the following:

- (A) That Amerada Petroleum Houston No. 3 located 600 feet from the north line and 1900 feet from the east line of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico is a gas well in the Monument Gas Pool.
- (B) That the subject well was originally completed in the Eunice Pool March 13, 1936 and recompleted in the Monument Gas Pool June 10, 1954.
- (C) That the subject well is producing gas from the Monument Gas Pool and assigned a 160 acre non-standard operation unit which is the NE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 36 East.
- (D) That the applicant proposes to increase the gas unit size from 160 to 320 acres by including the NW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 36 East with the present unit.
- (E) That Tidewater Oil Company and Atlantic are owner and operator of the W/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 7, and Sinclair is owner and operator of the E 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 36 East. That Tidewater-Atlantic, Sinclair, and Amerada leases comprise the proposed 320 acre gas operation unit described above.
