3542' Total Depth Line, Reset Baker Retrievable Cement retainer and tested casing with 800# for 30 Minutes and was OK, Retainer set at 860', Picked up drill pipe and found top of cement at 865' and tested with 800# for 30 minutes and dropped to 425#, drilled out cement and tested casing with 800# and dropped to 300# in 15 minutes and was OK, Made trip and put on new bit 7 3/8" and started making 7 3/8" hole below 3542' at 8AM May 31, 1947.
