Gentlemen:

On April 17, 1956, Tide Water Associated Oil Company, as Operator, filed application for permit to drill Pacific Western Oil Corporation's D. C. Hardy Well #5, in the Blinebry and/or Tubb Gas Pools, Lea County, New Mexico. Since this application was filed, Pacific Western Oil Corporation has changed its name to Getty Oil Company.

Tide Water Associated Oil Company now respectfully requests that we be granted a permit to dually complete this well in the Blinebry and Tubb Pools as a gas-gas well, and in support thereof state as follows:

1. D. C. Hardy Well #5 is located 660 feet from the South line and 760 feet from the East line of Section 20, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. The well will be drilled to an approximate depth of 6300 feet.
3. The Blinebry gas zone is expected to be encountered between 5550 feet and 5800 feet.
4. The Tubb gas zone is expected to be encountered between 6150 feet and 6200 feet.
5. We propose to set 5-1/2 inch casing to total depth with perforations opposite the Blinebry gas zone, which shall be produced through the casing. Perforations will be made opposite the Tubb gas zone for gas production through the tubing.
6. A packer will be set between the two sets of perforations to separate the two producing intervals.
7. The dual completion of this well will be in the interest of conservation, and the method of dually completing has been proven to be feasible and practical.

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
