Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

Rigged up unit to recomplate well from Hare Pool to Wants Abe Pool. Well had been produced by gas lift from Hare Pool. Unable to remove packer and 2-7/8 by 1-1/4 EUE chamber below packer. Cut off 2-3/8 EUE tubing at 7380 feet, leaving hookwall packer and anchor assembly in well extending from 7380 to 7845 feet. Using PWC, set Baker cast iron bridge plug at 7349 feet capped with 2 sacks Lenox Portland cement. Tested 5-1/2 inch casing with 2500 psig using fresh water. No pressure loss in 30 minutes. Proceeded to perforate casing opposite Abe formation.
