FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

The subject well, on the latest test, pumped 4 B0 and no wtr w/19.3 MCFG, GOR 4825.

Permission is requested to perform the following work: Run retrievable BP on wireline and set at 6550'; load hole with oil; perforate the Upper Drinkard w/2 JSPP from 6438-44, 6456-60, 6482-88, 6490-92, 6496-98, 6507-15 and 6536-42'; run 2-1/2" tubing, spot 2,000 gal 15% LSTNE acid over perfs and shut-in overnight; frac with 10,000 gals crude, 10,000 lb sand and 500 lb "Adomite" in five stages using ten ball sealers between stages; shut-in overnight; test well and retrieve bridge plug; place well on production.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of this work.
