Madame:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval to amend Order NSL-152 by reducing the 320-acre non-standard Eumont Gas Proration Unit comprising the south half of section 24, to a 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit. The reason for the reduction is due to the recent completion of the H.T. Mattern (NCT-A) Well No. 6 (API No. 30-025-34265) as an Eumont Oil well. This well is located 1980' FSL and 660' FWL of Unit L, Section 24, T-21-S, R-36-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. At this time we are also requesting simultaneous dedication of the H.T. Mattern (NCT-A) Wells No. 2 and 5 to the above listed 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit. The 280-acre proration unit will be formed by deleting the NW / 4 SW / 4 of said Section 24 from the current proration unit. In support thereof, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. states the following facts:

- 1) Order NSP-152, dated June 15, 1955, established a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool comprising the S / 2 of Section 24, in T-21-S, R-36-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2) Order NSP-152-A(SD), dated May 31, 1991, deleted the SW / 4 SW / 4 of section 24 from the GPU making it a 280-acre GPU in order to form an oil proration unit for the H. T. Mattern (NCT-A) # 5 Eumont Oil well, and dedicated the H. T. Mattern (NCT-A) # 2 and H.T. Mattern (NCT-A) # 1 to the GPU.
- 3) Order NSP-152(SD), is reinstated on August 16, 1996, re-establishing a 320-acre GPU and simultaneously dedicating the H.T. Mattern (NCT-A) # 5 to the GPU.
