DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was making 99% water and on 1-3-42 was plugged back from 3770' to 3762'. Well pumped 100% water and on 1-20-42 was plugged back to 3754' with 2 sacks of El Torro cement, and well pumped 100% water and pumped off. On 1-28-42, well was acidized with 500 gallons and pumped 1 barrel of oil in eight minutes and pumped off. Reacidized 2-3-42 with 500 gallons and pumped 320 barrels of water only in 24 hours. After plugging back to 3749' with 2 sacks of El Torro Cement, well pumped 1 barrel of oil in nine minutes and pumped off. Well was reacidized on 2-17-42 with 500 gallons and on a seven day pumping test, pumped and estimated 13 bbls. of water per hour with no oil. Well shut in as of
