WE propose to drill <sup>7 7/8"</sup> ~~3 1/4"~~ hole from 2855' to top of drinkard pay (approximately 6480'). Run 5 1/2" 15.50# casing to this point and cement with 400 sks. cement.

After 72 hrs. set time on cement plug will be drilled with 4 3/4" bitt. Drinkard pay to be drilled WITH under pipe and well completed in open hole.

Both casing and cement will be tested with 1500# pump pressure at time plug is drilled.
