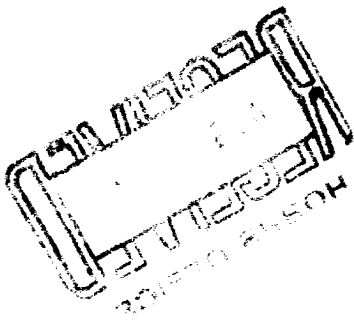
Dear Sirs:

Our L. E. Grizzell #2, Paddock well in Unit A of Section 8, Township 22, Range 37, Lea County, New Mexico was placed on the New Mexico proration schedule on July 1, 1948 with an allowable of 1891 barrels for the month of July 1948. A pipeline connection to the well was not obtained until July 17, 1948 and only 1088 barrels of oil were run during July, leaving a shortage of 803 barrels.

Will you please grant the Humble Pipe Line Company permission to run the shortage of 803 barrels during the month of August 1948?
