Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

This well was spudded April 4, 1958. A 17 1/4" hole was drilled to 230'. 13 3/8", 48#, H-40 casing was cemented at 223' using 225 sacks of regular cement with 2% gel and 2% CaCl added. Cement was circulated to the surface. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours before resuming drilling operations. The casing and cement job was pressure tested to 500 psi for 30 minutes and found to be ok.
