DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 11th, at 11:00 AM, 90 hours had elapsed since setting 5178 feet of 9-5/8" OD 56# Seamless Casing and cemented with 600 sacks of cement to be used for salt string. At this time casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 600 lbs was built up and held for one hour, and as test was OK, the cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 600 lbs. again built up and held for one hour. In this test, too, was OK, drilling operations were resumed.
