Dear Sir:

Regarding your "Notice of Intention to Drill" for your S. R. Cooper #1. I have been delayed on this and hope I haven't caused your company any unnecessary delays.

Please advise as to what size hole each string of pipe will be set in as this is a necessity if computing cement to be used. In making "Notice of Intention to Drill" on future wells, please show casing data as follows:

12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " OD in 15" hole
9-5/8" OD in 11" hole
7" OD in 8 $\frac{1}{4}$ " hole

Then if you will show the number of sacks of cement I can compute the theoretical top of the cement behind each string of pipe.

In case you get ready to set the surface pipe on this well prior to receiving your approved SG-101 please get in touch with me by telephone or wire.

Dear Sir:

Kindly refer to your letter of June 25, calling our attention to form SG-101 covering our S. R. Cooper No. 1. For the amount of cement to be used in setting casing we wish to refer you to our report stating that 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " would be cemented with 100 sacks, 9 $\frac{5}{8}$ " with 300 sacks and 7" with 150 sacks. On our next series of reports to your office we will show the size of hole to be drilled and the size of casing to be set.

Our Mr. J. P. Ruckman will notify you by telephone prior to the setting of surface pipe in this well.
