DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The production from this well had declined to approximately 18 bbls. oil and 70 bbls. water per day. On 10-10-51 pulled rods and tubing and cleaned well out to total depth of 3676'. On 10-11-51 ran tubing, spotted Dowell Jelly Seal on bottom and let set for 30 min. Acidised with 2000 gals. Dowell X 15 % acid, Max. press. 1000 psi, min. press. 675 psi. Flushed tubing with 21 bbls. oil, ran pump and placed well on production. The well is now producing 100 bbls. oil and 186 bbls. water per day.
