Gentlemen:

Herewith is submitted in triplicate application for an exception to the No-Flare Order insofar as it pertains to the T. F. Hodge Pubco State Well No. 2 located 660' from the North line and 661.49' from the East line of Section 32, T-26-S, R-37-E. The well was completed in the Julmat Pool June 21, 1958 and has a gas-oil ratio of 579:1. The volume of gas to be flared is approximately 13.4 MCFGPD.

There are two other wells completed on this lease which consists of the NE/4 NE/4 and Lots 1 and 2 of Section 32, T-26-S, R-37-E. They are the Pubco State Well No. 1 located 1864.5' from the North line and 661.49' from the East line, and the Pubco State Well No. 3 located 2081.46' from the North line and 1984.47' from the East line of Section 32.

We are presently negotiating with Cabot Carbon Co. for the sale of the gas from the lease and expect to have a contract in the near future. In view of this fact we respectfully request that an exception to the No-Flare Order be granted the T. F. Hodge Pubco State Well No. 2.

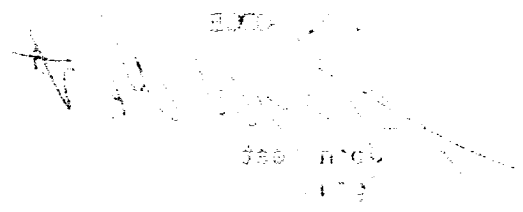
