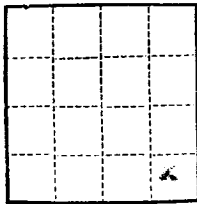

Cemented with 350 sacks. Reg. 4% Gel + 2% CaCl2. Pumped plug to 293' at 1:15 A.M. 1/6/63.

After 24 hours pressured up to 1000# psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling out cement. Test O. K.
