Gentlemen:

Attached is a copy of a letter from this office to Shell dated March 21, 1973, in which we pointed out certain things that would need to be done before we could approve Form C-104 and authorize the sale of gas from your Antelope Ridge Unit Well No. 4 located in Unit B of Section 4, T-24-S, R-34-E.

The requested Form C-102 and deviation surveys were subsequently submitted, but we have never received a Notice of Gas Connection from Southern Union Gas Company. Consequently, Form C-104 has never been approved for this well, but the well has been producing and the gas has been sold to Southern Union since 1973.

By copy of this letter, we are advising Southern Union Gas Company of the necessity of submitting a Notice of Gas Connection for our records in order that we may process Form C-104.
