- C. Flora and Fauna - The vegetative cover is generally sparse and consists of mesquite bushes, catclaws, and native grasses. Wildlife includes rabbits, coyotes, rodents, reptiles, dove and quail.
- D. Ponds and Streams - There are no rivers, streams, lakes or ponds in the area.
- E. Residences and Other Structures - There are no residences in the area.
- F. Land Use - Grazing.
- G. Surface Ownership - The surface is privately owned and to date a workable agreement with surface owner has not been achieved. Attached is Exhibit "D", a letter whereby Texas Pacific offered to pay location damages for this well, the same amount recently paid to other landowners in the area. The surface is owned by the Whitten Estate. The Administrator for the Estate is The New Mexico Bank and Trust of Hobbs, New Mexico. Mr. George F. Stanley, Vice-President and Trust Officer, has declined our offer for damages. Texas Pacific respectfully requests the restoration of the surface be approved as set out above in paragraph 10, in lieu of an agreement with the surface owner.
